

Lowther House - House Rules for dog owners

Only small to medium dogs can be accommodated.

This is due to the size of our rooms. As we want both you and your pet to enjoy your stay with us we have to limit the size of dogs we allow. We do not accommodate dogs larger than a cocker spaniel and reserve the right to refuse your booking should we feel that the dog is too large.

Owners are completely responsible for their dogs behaviour.

Damage to furnishings and / or décor will be charged to your final bill.

Please keep your dog on a lead at all times in the house and around the grounds

Unless your dog is very obedient and can be called to heel, we ask that you keep your pet on a lead. This is for the safety of our cat and wild life in the garden.

We do not allow pets in the dining room during meal service.

Our dining room is quite small therefore during meal times we ask that you leave your pet in the room (if you are confident that they will not be distressed) or put them in your car. We must consider other guests who may not like having a dog in the room during food service. Additionally, your dog could be a tripping hazard if they are excitable or over friendly.

No dirty paws in the rooms!

Please bring a towel for your dogs paws to avoid water and mud being taken up the stairs into the room. We can supply you with a cloth if you do not have a towel with you.

Beds, bedding and cages.

We do not allow dogs on our beds so please bring whatever bedding they require. We are happy to remove a piece of furniture from the room if you have a cage that requires more space.
